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Family Support

After a hard fought battle, James Gregory Jr. lost his battle to cancer while in his mid-30's. He left behind a young wife and 5 childrenages 2 through 13. Through our Emergency Fund, Piggyback Foundation was able to help the family make several trips to Chicago, where Jim was receiving treatment at CTCA. PBF also provided help with groceries, family activities, holiday meals/gifts, and referrals to grief counseling services.



At age 55, Ann and Larry Johnston have a 4 year old girl named Marie. Caring for their extended family members, visiting car shows, and revamping their historical home kept them young and busy. Life was fun until Ann was diagnosed with an aggressive form of cancer. PBF was able to provide a memorable camping trip for the family before Ann's passing.

4 year old Emily was diagnosed with brain cancer. Emily was recently selected through the Make-A-Wish Program for a trip to Disney World. Piggy-back provided the funds for Emily's grandma to join the family on this trip.



JJ was diagnosed in August with stage 3 Burkitt's Lymphoma. He spent nearly 3 months in the hospital after he was diagnosed. He finished his last round of chemo on Nov 22, 2013 and is now considered in complete remission. He is a 6th grader at Western Reserve Elementary. He loves all sports and is even back to playing basketball right now. Piggyback was able to provide funds through our Kids Count program for JJ's necessary sports gear. In addition, Piggyback was able to provide dance lessons for JJ's sister and through our Education Counts program an Ipad was provided for JJ.



Darlene Meade was diagnosed with metastatic lung cancer. Through the Family Counts program, Piggyback was able to send Darlene and her family on their very first beach vacation and arranged for renewal of their wedding yows.


