

We are currently helping 27 families in the Huron and Erie county area.

The Piggyback Foundation celebrated Hannah's remission and senior year of high school by providing senior pictures. The Foundation also helped keep her sister, Abi, in dance classes through the Kids Count program. This fall, Hannah will be using a scholarship provided by PBF Education Counts program toward her schooling at Cleveland State, where she will be studying to be a pediatric oncologist one day.

The Rumer Family- Spencer, 13, has been battling cancer on and off for five years. The Piggyback Foundation has been there to provide gas cards and hotel stays through the Emergency Fund with their many trips to and from St. Judes. The Foundation also helped sister Kylee get a cap and gown and other graduation essentials through our Education Counts program.
