Family Stories

Madelyn's Story

Our daughter Madelyn was diagnosed with NF1 (neurofibromatosis type 1) as a baby, and in 2023, we also learned she had bilateral optic pathway gliomas (tumors on both optic nerves, which can affect vision, hormone levels, and overall brain function). Since then, she's undergone weekly chemotherapy. It's been a challenging road—balancing treatment, travel, work, and parenting two young kids. Life shifted dramatically, and it's something for which no family is ever really prepared.

The Piggyback Foundation brought light to our lives in a difficult season. They helped us take a magical North Pole train ride at Christmas, supported birthdays, and aided in the enrollment of my son, Clay, in sports.

It's not just the gifts or experiences—it's the way my liaisons, Amy Parcher and Laura Winkler, show up. They came to birthday parties, fundraising events, and continue to check in on us. That kind of love and consistency is rare, and it means the world to us.

Maddie is continuing her chemo treatments and being closely monitored. She just finished her first year of preschool and will be moving up to the 4s Pre-K class this fall! She amazes us every day with her resilience and joy.

There are so many moments Piggyback made brighter, but that North Pole train ride is one we'll never forget. In the middle of a season that felt heavy, it gave our kids pure magic. Seeing Maddie and Clay laugh, smile, and be kids without worry—that's something I'll treasure forever.



Bud's Story

On June 15th, 2024, my husband, Bud, was diagnosed with cancer to the liver. The only option for treatment was a liver transplant, but to proceed, the primary source of cancer must be removed and a year must pass to see if he qualifies to be put on the transplant list.

It was difficult to ask for help. We were a hardworking, independent family. But The Piggyback Foundation did not make us feel ashamed. And they have, without a doubt, lifted so much stress off our family during this difficult time.

They have allowed our children to continue participating in school activities and extracurricular sports. Our daughter graduated last May. The Piggyback Foundation

helped her with prom and graduation. Our son was able to continue playing the sports he loves without worrying about equipment. We have been supported with meals, fun activities, and words of encouragement and prayer. We were even introduced to another family who had gone through similar circumstances, with kids close in age to ours, and they have become amazing friends.

I can't say enough about this organization. They are heaven-sent to our family while going through such a difficult time in our lives. We are still praying and fighting for a miracle that Bud can beat this awful disease! We remain optimistic and hold our Lord close.
